Waitangi Day 2025 Tāngata Whenua - Tāngata Tiriti: Kotahitanga

An archival programme from the collection of Ngā Taonga Sound & Vision

In honour of the Treaty and to celebrate Waitangi Day 2025 Ngā Taonga Sound & Vision present *Tāngata Whenua – Tāngata Tiriti: Kotahitanga*.

This year's Waitangi Day archival film compilation has been thoughtfully curated with audiovisual footage from the 1970s and 1980s.

He rangatira, he Pirimia, he kaitōrangapū, he tātarāmoa, he Tāngata Whenua, he Tāngata Tiriti, e takitaki ana i ngā kōrero tuku iho ā rātou. He oti, ka mātaitia te pūtake o te Tiriti, me te aha ko te ora ngātahi a ngā ira tāngata e rua te tāhūhū, ko te Kotahitanga te hiranga mahara ka puta ka ora.

A compilation of taonga featuring viewpoints and voices of Tangata Whenua and Tangata Tiriti speaking at Waitangi Treaty Grounds over the decades. From rangatira to former Prime Ministers, these speeches acknowledge the foundations of the Treaty, the concept of partnership and the strong binding notion of kotahitanga (unity).

Kotahitanga – unity **Tāngata Whenua** – people of the land (Māori)

Rangatira – a Māori chief: a person of rank, authority, or distinction

Taonga – treasure **Tangata Tiriti** – people of the Treaty (non-Māori)
